## **Cardiac: Narrow Complex Tachycardia with Rate > 150**

## EMR

- ABC and vital signs
- Airway management with oxygen therapy maintaining a SaO2 of 94-98% through titration
- Have AED available

- Cardiac Monitor
- Obtain 12 lead ECG if monitor notes "STEMI" or "Acute MI", do not delay transport.

## **Key Points/Considerations**

• UNSTABLE is defined as ventricular rate > 150 bpm with symptoms of chest pain, dyspnea, altered mental status, pulmonary edema, or hypotension (systolic bp < 100 mmHg)
