# **IPRATROPIUM BROMIDE (Atrovent)**

### **CLASSIFICATION**

Bronchodialator

### **ACTION**

1. Causes bronchodilation, dries respiratory tract secretions.

## **INDICATIONS**

1. Bronchospasm in patients with reversible obstructive airway disease

### **CONTRAINDICATIONS**

1. Patients with history of hypersensitivity to the drug

## **USE WITH CAUTION**

- 1. Patients in cardiovascular disease
- 2. Elderly patients generally require a lower dose
- 3. Should not be used as primary agent in acute treatment of bronchospasm. Utilize Albuterol with or before.

## SIDE EFFECTS

Tremor, nervousness, dizziness, insomnia, headache, tachycardia, palpitations, hypertension, drying and irritation of nose and throat, heartburn, nausea and vomiting, muscle cramps.
