Medical: Toxic Exposure

EMR

- Decontamination as needed
- ABC and vital signs
- Airway management with oxygen therapy maintaining a SaO2 of 94-98% through titration
- Determine what the patient was exposed to, when and how much, if possible and contact poison control
- If nerve agent or organophosphate is suspected be prepared to administer DuoDote auto injector to yourself or your crew as needed and if available.
