# **NITROGLYCERINE TABLETS**

#### **CLASSIFICATION**

Vasodilator

#### **ACTION**

- 1. Dilates veins and arteries in peripheral circulation resulting in:
  - a. Reduced resistance to blood flow
  - b. Decreased blood pressure
  - c. Decreased workload on heart
- 2. Dilates coronary arteries
- 3. Dilates blood vessels in smooth muscle; i.e., gastrointestinal tract, gallbladder, bile ducts, uterus
- 4. Improves cardiac output in patient with congestive heart failure

#### **INDICATIONS**

- 1. Angina pectoris
- 2. Severe hypertension
- 3. Refractory congestive heart failure

## **CONTRAINDICATIONS**

- 1. Known hypersensitivity
- 2. Hypotension: BP below 100 systolic
- 3. Caution with Viagra and similar drug types

### **USE WITH CAUTION**

1. Hypotension
