Pediatric: Overdose

EMR

- ABC and vital signs
- Airway management with **oxygen** therapy maintaining a SaO2 of 94-98% through titration
- Determine what was taken, when and how much, if possible
- *Check blood glucose level, if equipped, if altered mental status is present, or if overdose of oral hypoglycemic agents is suspected. If level is abnormal, refer to Pediatric Diabetic Protocol



EMT

- Cardiac Monitor
- For symptomatic opioid overdose give **Narcan** 0.1 mg/kg IN or *IM to max of 2 mg



EMT IV

Vascular access



ADVANCED EMT

• For symptomatic opioid overdose give Narcan 0.1 mg/kg IV or IO to max of 2 mg
