

Pediatric: Severe Pain Management

EMR

- ABC and vital signs
- Airway management with **oxygen** therapy maintaining a SaO₂ of 94-98% through titration

 **EMR STOP**

EMT

- If patient is old enough and capable of holding mask, consider administration of ***Nitrous Oxide**. Do not administer to patient if they are too young to understand or are unable to hold the mask (do not assist the patient in holding the mask).
- Cardiac Monitor
- If patient can swallow consider **Ibuprofen** 10 mg/kg for pain.

 **EMT STOP**

EMT IV

ADVANCED EMT

- Consider vascular access

 **EMT IV / ADVANCED EMT STOP**
