

## Pediatric: Toxic Exposure

### EMR

- Decontamination as needed.
- ABC and vital signs
- Airway management with **oxygen** therapy maintaining a SaO<sub>2</sub> of 94-98% through titration
- Determine what the patient was exposed to, when and how much, if possible and contact poison control center
- If a nerve agent or organophosphate are suspected be prepared to administer DuoDote auto injector to yourself or your crew as needed and if available.

- Cardiac Monitor
- Consider 12 Lead EKG if tachycardic
